## PROGRAMMES AT SCHOOL FOR STUDENTS

**DEBATE ACTIVITY** - Debate activity was conducted for Grade 5 students on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2018 to inculcate in children the fine art of healthy discussion.

LANGUAGE ACTIVITY - Language activity was conducted for Grade 2, 3 & 4 students to teach children the importance of language and communication.

**BRIGHT SPOT AWARDS** - Tattva celebrated the spontaneity of teachers by gifting them the Bright Spot Award certificates & badges for selected members on  $6^{\text{th}}$  August 2018, to acknowledge their effort in doing things encourage and motivate them.

HSCP GUIDELINES OF SAFETY - HSCP Team conducted a training session for the Transport and Housekeeping staff on 7th August 2018 and explained to them of the importance of child safety, and mental & physical well-being of every individual, under their care. She also said that the freedom is very precious and it is very necessary to preserve it. This was followed by teachers' speeches in Hindi on the occasion. In the end of the ceremony, sweets were distributed among the assembled audience. Sports activity was conducted by Decathlon to instill respect for sports amongst all students and all enjoyed it.

FIRE DRILL PROGRAMME - A mock fire drill was organized to teach the





team how to react to a similar emergency. It involved creating a situation which replicates what would happen if a real fire were to occur, with the inclusion of fire alarms and all had to evacuate in a systematic manner. This drill was intended to familiarize the team with the procedures, so that the relevant fire warden or fire safety supervisor knows exactly what they are doing and can act as incredibly beneficial practice if their expertise is ever really needed. Fire Drill programme was conducted for the students on 18th August 2018.

FANCY DRESS COMPETITION - The Pre-primary section conducted a 'Fancy Dress Competition' to celebrate India's 72<sup>nd</sup> Independence.
