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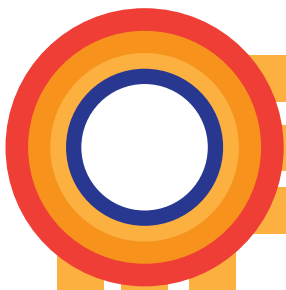
EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

CLASS AND SPORTS ACTIVITIES - GRADES I TO X

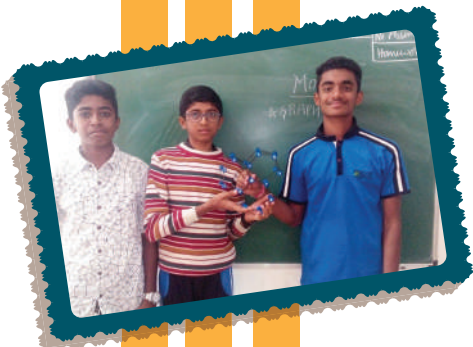

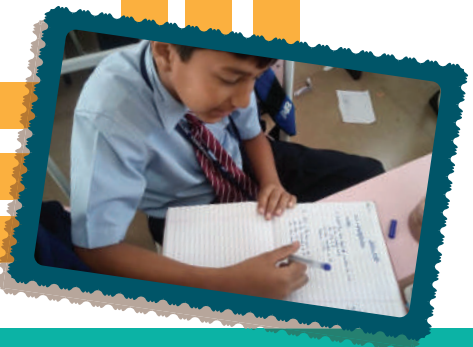
Lab Activity and Project Exhibition - Inter class science Lab activity and project exhibition was conducted by Grade X students.

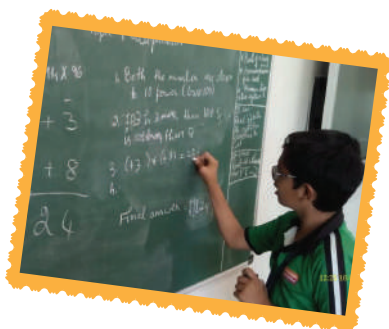
It also contains the history of multiple travelers (real) who were martyred for the mapping of Africa. The book is set in the 19th century.
